Tasting notes

Eye: attractive red color

Nose: it develops an expressing fruit nose with lingering red fruit aromas (cherry, blackcurrant, red currant, etc..)

Mouth: we find again the red fruits in the mouth making this wine a very fruity, enjoyable, refined and fresh Pinot Noir, which is very food friendly and showing a pleasant freshness.

Food & Wine

It will partner a wide range of dishes, especially on Summertime, from light cold and hot starters, barbecue, red and game meats (duck, venison), charcuterie, light hard cheeses and gratin of soft red fruits as unusual matches!

Origin

Various hill-sides around the little village of Bergheim with a predominance of heavy soils compound by clay and limestone.
