### Tasting notes

Eye : light yellow colour with green tints.

Nose : tender, fine and elegant. Notes of orange blossom and linden, as well as white fruits and vine peach.

Mouth : fresh, well balanced and dry. Greedy, soft, pure with a good acidity.

### Food & Wine

It's a great matching with hot or cold starters, white fishes, mussels and cold fish pate. Perfect wine by the glass, with a buffet or on a warm day when thirsty!

### Origin

Various hill-sides around the little village of Bergheim with a predominance of heavy soils compound by clay and limestone.
